MUSIC TALKS SESSIONS launches what is the first off-line, peer-to-peer forum for independent artists in the music industry.

"Traditional expos are needed, but the on-going nature of MUSIC TALKS serves to build closer relationships among artists and most importantly gives the independent artist a voice of their own in the music industry", says David Knight.

The event, now only in its fourth monthly installment is gaining support and recognition from the indie community.
