Long standing hip-hop culture symbol and rap artist LL Cool J and smooth R&B voice Bill Withers will be honored by The American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) at this years 19th Annual Rhythm & Soul Music Awards on June 26, 2006
