Corner Boyz also released a highly successful Mixtape/DVD titled Corner Boyz Worldwide/Chronicles. Baby Stone rose to local celebrity status on the strength of album sales and performances with hip-hop heavy weights like fellow rap artists Mike Jones, Trick Daddy, and Pastor Troy.

Baby Stone re-entered the studio in October of 2005 and began work on his second album, simply entitled 'Brighter Days'. With this album, Baby Stone confidently tackles serious issues like taking care of one's children ("I'm Gonna Hustle"), toys with his hometown's infamous "Snitches," and prophesizes his worldwide domination of the rap game in "Coast To Coast."

Determined to shine a positive light on his dark past, Baby Stone has wrested control of his own destiny and become a formidable player in the Hip Hop world. Music critics have described Brighter Days as polished, mature, and real; indicative of an artist whose time has come. "On this I was in different state of mind than with the first album. This time I touched on a lot of subjects I feel strongly about. I'm in a different place, we're moving forward. We've shed tears, poured out liquor and smoked blunts, now its time to move on to Brighter Days," Baby Stone says.
