Truly an international superstar, the album has sold over a million copies worldwide and continues to build on the success of singles "We Be Burnin," "Temperature," and "Ever Blazin."

"The Trinity" is the follow-up to Sean's smash hit "Dutty Rock," which sold more than 6 million copies worldwide.
