"Trick Daddy is going to help our efforts as we continue rebuilding the centers and stability for these families affected by Hurricane Katrina in this critical time. The victims of this national disaster are going to need help for the next 2-5 years."

Trick Luvs Da Kids Foundation, Inc. will host this year's Halloween Spooktacular Costume Party in Miami, Florida on October 29, 2005. Held at Solo at 10890 Collins Avenue Sunny Isles Beach, Florida, the adult fundraising event will provide giveaways including prizes for Best Dressed Female Costume, Best Dressed Male Costume and Best Dressed Couple Costume. A donation of \$100 will include food and drinks all night with general admission slated at \$25. The proceeds from this adult event will benefit the Single Parent Initiative and the Boys & Girls Clubs in both Mississippi and New Orleans.

"Florida was just hit by Katrina ourselves and we were just getting over it when I started hearing about what was going on in the coastal areas," explains Trick Daddy.
