Crooked I says "They're (Treacherous) distributing my label through their distribution deal with Universal, so I have the greatest deal of a lifetime. I'm in here making what a person should make off their album with all the distribution in the world and legally they can't do anything because of this (cease and desist) order (Suge Knight's lawyers have sent).
