

"He just arrived, and I have no clue how long he"ll be here," the prison's Sergeant Arioma Sams said. "How long he's going to remain here would be up to his parole agent, and then ultimately up to the Board of Prison Terms."

While at the California Institution for Men, Suge Knight's case will be reviewed by his parole agent, and if that agent finds that Knight did in fact violate his parole, the case will go before California's Board of Prison Terms to determine how long he will remain behind bars. But even if it's determined that Mr. Knight did not violate his parole, his case would still be heard before the board, since he is listed as a "mandatory referral" because of the violent nature of his initial arrest.

When asked whether or not Marion 'Suge'Knight will be released in time to attend this weekend's Grammy Awards in Los Angeles, Sams answered, "I have no idea."
