According to Owens, "The question most often asked is, "Does the title say what I think it says?" The title stems from a scripture in the Bible, Hebrews 12:8 which states that if a man refuses chastisement and purging from God, he is a bastard and not a son. That's the premise for the book and the scripture is part of the title. This book is a mandate for me. When people understand what the book is dealing with, many agree, including church leadership, and anticipate reading the book."

Owens is President and Founder of Higher Standard Publishers, LLC, an African-American publishing company which has developed its own method of distribution and marketing for African-American and multi-ethnic Christian authors. Currently, the company is undergoing a search for 101 authors to be published, marketed and distributed nationwide through bookstores and its online Affiliate Program.
