The rift between **Suge Knight** and former **N.W.A** members continues to this day.

Former CEO of **Death Row records**, Suge Knight has filed a \$200 million defamation lawsuit against Dr. Dre and Ice Cube over the portrayal of his persona in hip hop blockbuster “**Straight Outta Compton**”

**leave Death Row like that. He cried like the little bitch he is begging me to let him keep his music, but I Debo'ed that and it wasn't a damn thing he was going to do about. He was a mark then and he is a mark now. I ran the entire California rap music scene for decades. No one on any label made a move without my say so. I don't know who that soft n\*gga was in that movie, but it wasn't Suge Knight."**

The Los Angeles County Jail where Knight is being held on murder charges is under investigation for allowing Knight to watch the film.

Suge was arrested for an incident in which he ran over and killed rap producer Terry Carter on the set of the movie "Straight Outta Compton" in January. Knight claims self defense and said his life was in danger.

Ice Cube nor Dr. Dre have yet to respond to the lawsuit.
